DISCUSSION GUIDE

ON CHAPTERS 1-7

- 1. What did you think about how people in Moab responded to the Israelites at first? What did Ruth think of them, and how did her view change?
- 2. Why was worshipping God different to worshipping the Moabite "gods"?
- 3. Read Ruth 1:6-18. Why do you think Orpah stayed in Moab while Ruth left with Naomi? What would you have done?
- 4. What impression did you have of Naomi in these chapters? What was she like? Do you think you would have got on with her?

ON CHAPTERS 8-15

5. What was Bethlehem like when Ruth and Naomi arrived? Do you think it was what they were expecting?

The Outsider

- 6. What do you think it was like for Ruth to go out to the fields for the first time? How would you have been feeling if you were her?
- 7. What was Boaz like? Why do you think he was so kind to Ruth?
- 8. Read Ruth 2:11-12 and 19-20. What do Boaz and Naomi think about what God is like?

ON CHAPTERS 16-21

- 9. What do you think of God's commands about redeemers? Do you think that was a good system?
- 10. Do you think you would have found it easy or hard to trust the Lord if you were Ruth in this part of the story?
- 11. What does the threshing-floor part of the story tell us about what Ruth was like?
- 12. Read Ruth 3:7-11. What did Boaz think about Ruth and why?

ON CHAPTERS 22-24 AND EPILOGUE

- 13. What are some reasons for Boaz not to marry Ruth? Why do you think he did it anyway?
- 14. Read Ruth 1:20-21 and 4:14-15. How did Naomi's relationship with God change throughout the story? Was she right or wrong about him at the beginning?

The Outsider

- 15. What similarities did you spot between Abraham and Ruth? What do their stories tell you about what it means to have faith?
- 16. What impression of God did you get throughout the story? How could that impact your own life?
- 17. What does it mean that Jesus is a redeemer? How does it make you feel about yourself and about him?
