## CHAPTER 4: IT WAS ALL GOOD

Have you ever seen a picture of someone's creation fail? They can be pretty funny. Someone may post a beautiful photograph of a cake they were trying to make, shaped like a puppy. Next to that perfect cake, they'll share the picture of the cake they actually made—and it looks like a misshapen slug with three eyes.

Maybe you've had a creation fail too. Perhaps you wanted to draw your sister, but the way she looked in your head and the way she looks on the paper are two very different pictures. Everyone has had the experience of making something that is less than perfect. Everyone, that is, except God.
You see, God is perfect. He is holy and has never sinned. He is the King of the universe, the Creator of all things. When God made the universe, the earth, and every living thing, his creation was very good. In fact, in 1 Timothy 4:4a (ESV), Paul tells us that "everything created by God is good."

Now, when you say good, you may mean "good enough." But when the Bible tells us that God calls something good, it means...
(1) Perfect
(2) Excellent
(2) Approved of by God

In the beginning, God created the heavens and the earth (there's a merism!), and everything God created was good. Not just good but perfect-just the way God wanted it. God made a world without sin.

But Adam and Eve—the first people God made—disobeyed God's clear instructions not to eat the fruit of one tree. Their disobedience introduced sin into the world and the world became corrupted. Even that wasn't a surprise to God. Nope. Our Father always had a salvation plan for all people. We'll take a look at that plan in the last section of this investigator book. But first, let's learn about God's perfect, excellent, approved-of world!
