

# PRAY



**When We Pray, What Do We Say?**  
Jesus taught us to **PRAISE** our Father in heaven!

## What You'll Need

- White paper plate
- Blue paint or crayons/ markers
- Scissors
- Glue stick
- Googly eyes or marker
- String or yarn (optional hanger)

## Instructions

- 1. Create the Bubble Shape**  
Cut the paper plate into a large circle if needed. This will be Poppy's bubble body.
- 2. Decorate Poppy**  
Paint or color the plate light blue.
- 3. Add a Face**  
Glue on googly eyes or draw a happy face with markers.
- 4. Talk About Praise**  
Ask: "What is something we can praise God for today?"  
Write one word of praise on Poppy if desired (e.g., "Loving," "Powerful").



# PRAY

## When We Pray, What Do We Say?

Jesus taught us to **REPENT** of what we have done wrong!

### What You'll Need

- Gray or white paper
- Cotton balls
- Blue paper or yarn
- Glue
- Scissors
- Marker or crayon

### Instructions

- 1. Make the Cloud**  
Cut out a cloud shape from paper.
- 2. Fluff It Up**  
Glue cotton balls onto the cloud to make it soft and puffy.
- 3. Add Raindrops**  
Cut raindrops from blue paper or glue strands of blue yarn to the bottom.
- 4. Give Rainy a Face**  
Draw a gentle, thoughtful face on the cloud.
- 5. Talk About Repentance**  
Ask: "Why is it good to say sorry to God?"  
Remind children that God forgives us when we repent.

## When We Pray, What Do We Say? Jesus taught us to **ASK** God for the things we need!

### What You'll Need

- Red craft paper
- String or yarn
- Tape or glue
- Scissors
- Marker

### Instructions

- 1. Create the Balloon**  
Cut out a large balloon shape from paper.
- 2. Add Airy's Face**  
Draw a smiling face on the balloon.
- 3. Attach the String**  
Tape or glue a piece of string to the bottom of the balloon.
- 4. Write a Prayer Ask**  
On the balloon, write or draw something the child wants to ask God for.
- 5. Talk About Asking God**  
Ask: "Who can we pray for today?"  
Remind children God cares about what's on our hearts.



# PRAY

**When We Pray, What Do We Say?**  
Jesus taught us to **YIELD** to what God wants!

## What You'll Need

- Diamond-shaped paper (or square cut diagonally)
- Ribbon, yarn, or paper strips
- Glue or tape
- Scissors
- Marker

## Instructions

- 1. Make the Kite**  
Cut paper into a diamond shape.
- 2. Decorate Yessy**  
Draw a face and decorate the kite with patterns or stickers.
- 3. Add the Tail**  
Glue ribbon or paper strips to the bottom as the kite tail.
- 4. Write 'YES'**  
Write "YES, GOD!" somewhere on the kite.
- 5. Talk About Yielding**  
Ask: "What does it mean to trust God's way?"  
Explain that yielding means letting God lead.
