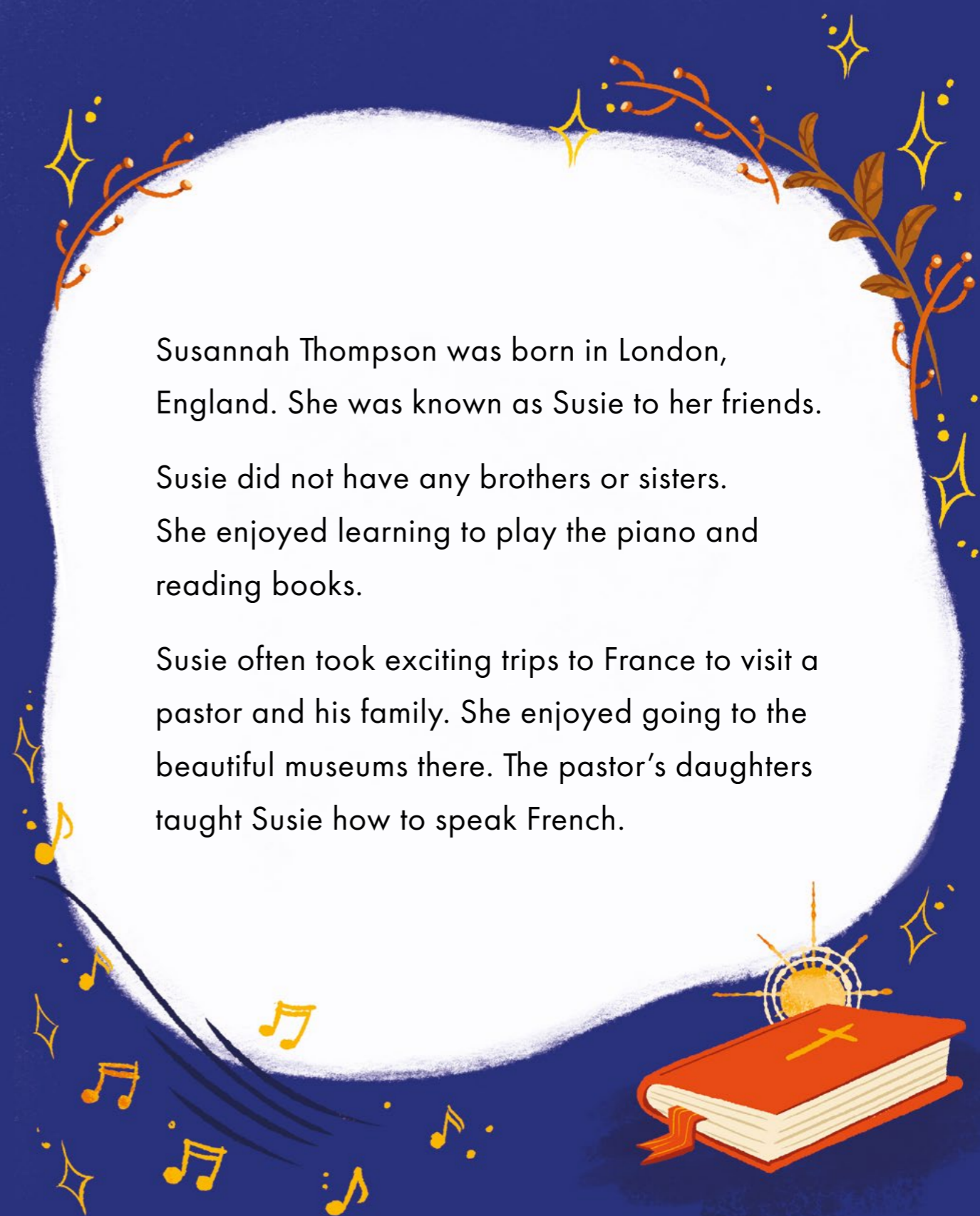




Susannah Thompson was born in London, England. She was known as Susie to her friends.
